2025 World Indoor Championships Selection Policy **A Quick Reference**.

This infographic is designed to give athletes and coaches a simple overview of the selection process. It does not replace the need to carefully read the full policy which can be found <u>here</u>.



Eligibility

Athletes aiming for selection must meet certain eligibility criteria:

- Athletes must fill out an Expression of Interest ("EOI") to be considered for selection (Deadline: 20 December 2024 for Combined Events, 28 February 2025 for all other events).
- Achievement of World Athletics ("WA") Entry Standard OR by WA Top Performance List placing.
- General eligibility as per WA and UKA rules.
- Being an 'Eligible Athlete' does not guarantee automatic selection.

How do I qualify for Combined Events?

- Email Head Coach, Paula Dunn **before 20 December** (pdunn@britishathletics.org.uk) and Sharon Morris (smorris@britishathletics.org.uk). All names will be submitted to World Athletics.
- Be in the Top 14 athletes placed athletes who receive an invitation from World Athletics based on WA World Rankings OR receive a discretionary WA invitation.

How do I qualify for individual events?

Qualification window for all other events: 24/02/2024 - 23/02/2025

You can qualify individually in one of 3 ways:

- 1. Be the 2025 World Indoor Tour Champion you will receive a wild card entry from WA
- 2. Achieve a WA Entry Standard
- 3. Be in the following placed positions on the Road to Nanjing on 10 March 2025:
 - For Field Events Top 16
 - For Track Events Top 20

Selection Process

There are a maximum of 2 places available per event

- Round 1: 2025 World Indoor Tour winners / 2024 Olympic Games individual medallists / 2024 World Indoor Championships individual medallists / Combined Event athletes
- **Round 2:** Remaining eligible athletes with WA entry standard or WA Top List placing. If more than one athlete, the athlete ranked higher on the Road to Nanjing on 10 March 2025 will be selected.



Notifications & Appeals Process

* Athletes who wish to pursue an appeal should familiarise themselves with the process in the Policy

- Athletes will be individually notified of their selection by 0900hrs Tuesday 11 March 2025
- Consult the UKA Fast Appeals process on website for grounds for appeal
- Note deadlines in the selection policy
- There is a £250 administration fee due upon Notice of Appeal. Refundable if appeal is upheld.

This document is intended to help simplify the selection policy. Athletes/coaches/agents/representatives should always consult the policy or contact a member of the performance team for advice. Where there is a perceived dispute between the content of this document and the policy, the policy itself will always be the final authority.
