AVIVA GB & NI TEAM PROFILES SENIOR MEN

Name: Andy Baddeley Club: Harrow Coach: Andy Hobdell Date of Birth: 20/06/1982

Biog: Andy Baddeley is best known for his feats on the track and he established himself as the UK's top metric miler in 2006, Major Championship track highlights include making finals at the Beijing Olympics (2008), World Championships in Osaka (2007) and European Championships in Sweden (2006). He last competed in the European Cross Country Championships in Toro, Spain in 2007 where he finished top Brit in 11th. A fourth place finish at the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/ European Cross Trials earned the 29-year-old a place in the Aviva GB & NI team for this year's event in Slovenia. Other highlights for the Wirralborn athlete in 2011 include finishing fourth over 3000m at the European Indoor Championships and retaining his title at the Boston Invitation Mile event

Name: Mark Draper Club: Bedford & County Coach: Andy Hobdell Date of Birth: 28/06/1984

Date of Birth: 26/06/1984
Biog: Mark Draper has continued his impressive
2010 form into 2011. He finished in a respectable
37th position at the European Cross Country
Championships in Albufeira, Portugal, 12 months
ago - fourth scoring athlete in the Aviva GB &
NI team - and retains his place for the second
successive season following an excellent
performance at the McCain Liverpool Cross
Challenge where he was a close second to Andy
Vernon. The 27-year-old, who has recently been
training at the UKA/London Marathon altitude
camp in Kenya, has clocked PBs over 5000m
[13:34.63] and 3000mSC [8:42.89] in 2011, the latter
when finishing third at the Aviva World Trials and
UK Championships.

Name: Ryan McLeod Club: Tipton Harriers Coach: John Nuttall Date of Birth: 07/06/1985

Biog: Rvan McLeod returned from the UKA/London Marathon altitude training camp in Iten, Kenya prior to the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/ European Trials and recorded his best ever placing in third - three places higher than in 2010. He had a positive start to 2011 with an 11th place finish (third Brit) in the International Team Challenge at the BUPA Great Edinburgh Cross Country in January. He was fourth in the McCain UK Cross Challenge Final/World Cross Trials and finished 83rd at the IAAF World Cross Country Championships in Punta Umbria, Spain. He was denied a podium finish in the UK Championships over 5000m, agonisingly finishing in fourth place, but clocked a number of PBs over the summer, most notably reducing his 5000m best by 13 seconds to 13:41.35. His dad is Mike McLeod, Olympic 10,000m silver medallist in Los Angeles 1984.

Name: Frank Tickner Club: Wells AC Coach: Self

Date of Birth: 12/10/1983
Biog: After another injury interrupted year. Frank

Tickner returned to competitive action with victory in the McCain Bristol Cross Challenge. Undoubtedly a cross country specialist, his best ever international performance came with a tenth place finish in the European Cross Country Championships in Brussels in 2008 when the Aviva GB & NI men won team bronze. His sixth place finish at the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/ European Cross Trials sealed a deserved place on the British team for the second successive year and an opportunity to improve on his 48th place finish 12 months ago.

AVIVA GB & NI TEAM PROFILES SENIOR MEN

Name: Andy Vernon

Club: Aldershot, Farnham & District

Coach: Nic Bideau Date of Birth: 07/01/1986

Biog: Andy Vernon enters this year's European Cross Country Championships in scintillating form after he won the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/European Cross Trials for the second successive year. After pulling out of last year's European Cross due to stomach cramps, he has realistic aspirations of a top ten finish in Slovenia. Twice a European under-23 cross country medallist, finishing third in 2007 and second in 2008, he finished 12th when stepping up to the senior category in Dublin 2009 and built on that with a credible 44th place finish in the IAAF World Cross Country Championships in Poland (2010). He was 58th at the 2011 World Cross, clocked a 5000m PB of 13:27.85 this summer and will be buoved by his late summer victory over the same distance at the World University Games in China.

Name: James Walsh Club: Leeds City Coach: Mike Baxter Date of Birth: 22/09/1981

Date of Birth: 22/09/1981 Biog: James Walsh will make his European Cross Country debut in Slovenia but has previously finished 126th (Edinburgh 2008) and 77th (Punta Umbria, Spain 2011) in the IAAF World Cross Country Championships. A fifth place finish at this year's McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/ European Cross Trials signalled a rapid improvement from last year's event when he was 18th, while throughout the year he has achieved PBs at almost every distance including 5000m (13:39:23) - a distance in which he was crowned English Champion - and 10,000m (28:37.30) when finishing sixth in the Aviva World Trials and UK Championships.

AVIVA GB & NI TEAM PROFILES SENIOR WOMEN

Name: Elle Baker Club: Stockport Coach: David Turnbull Date of Birth: 11/12/1983

Biog: Elle Baker will return to international duty at this year's European Cross Country Championships for the first time since she placed 60th in the IAAF World Cross Country Championships in Kenya in 2007. A seventh place finish, fifth senior, at the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/European Cross Trials earned her a place on the senior team and she comes into the Championships in good form after posting a quick time at the National Cross Country Relays. The European Cross event shares the same date as her birthday.

Name: Julia Bleasdale Club: Hillingdon Coach: Self Date of Birth: 09/09/1981

Date of Birth: U9/U9/1981
Blog: 2011 has been a good year for Julia
Bleasdale. The European Cross Country
Championships will be the second time in less than
12 months she will have pulled on an international
vest courtesy of her sixth place finish in the McCain
Liverpool Cross Challenge (fourth senior). A 59th
placed finish at the IAAF World Cross Country
Championships in March was a commendable
performance on her senior debut in that event and
in July, she became the UK national champion
over 5000m at the Aviav World Trials and UK
Championships. Throughout the summer she
recorded lifetime bests over 1500m (4:19.68),
3000m (9:9) 1 and 5000m (15:44.00).

Name: Hatti Dean Club: Hallamshire Coach: Bud Baldaro Date of Birth: 02/02/1982

Biog: Hatti Dean returned from the UKA/London Marathon altitude camp in Kenya to win an exciting McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/European Cross Trial race ahead of the in-form Gemma Steel. Her international cross country record speaks for itself. She was 21st (second Brit) at the 2011 IAAF World Cross Country in Spain and was the first Aviva GB & NI athlete home at the 2010 SPAR European Cross Country Championships in seventh, leading the team to the overall silver medal. The Yorkshire athlete was previously the top Aviva GB & NI team finisher at the 2007 World Cross Country Championships in Kenya finishing 15th. On the track she's also excelled, narrowly missing out on a medal in the 2010 European. Championships 3000mSC in fourth.

Name: Freya Murray Club: Chester-Le-Street Coach: Steve Jones Date of Birth: 20/09/1983

Biog: Freva Murray has been unlucky with injuries over the past few years but the Scottish athlete appears to have put those woes behind her in the last few months. In her first race back since winning the Scottish National Cross Country title in February, she clocked a half marathon PB of 72:44 in the Great North Run in October. In her first cross. country race of the 2011/2012 season, she earned a deserved spot on the podium after pipping under-23 Hannah Walker on the line to finish third in the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/ European Cross Trials. The north-east of England based athlete was an impressive seventh place in the 2009 European Cross Country Championships in Dublin where the Aviva GB & NI women won team silver. She competed for Scotland in the 2010 Commonwealth Games over 5000m and 10.000m. finishing fifth and seventh respectively.

AVIVA GB & NI TEAM PROFILES SENIOR WOMEN

Name: Gemma Steel Club: Charnwood AC Coach: John Nuttall Date of Birth: 12/11/1985

Biog: Having rapidly improved over the last few years to become a major force on the domestic cross country scene, Gemma Steel brought her 2010 to a close with a 27th place for the silver medal winning senior women's team at the SPAR European Cross Country Championships on her Aviva GB & Ni International debut. She has once again brought consistency to the table in 2011 with impressive performances in the McCain Cross Challenge Series – first place in Bristol followed up by a runners-up spot in Liverpool – in addition to taking the runbritain Grand Prix title on the roads. Earlier this year she made her debut at the IAAF World Cross Country Championship in which she achieved 54th position.

Name: Emily Wicks

Club: Aldershot, Farnham & District

Coach: Keith Donkin
Date of Birth: 27/01/1985

Biog: Emily Wicks will make her Aviva GB & NI debut at the 2011 European Championships. Her inclusion on the team is reward for her improving performances over the past 12 months. She finished in 10th place at the recent McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge – a significant improvement from 31st the previous two years. She is married to fellow cross country athlete Phil Wirks

AVIVA GB & NI TEAM PROFILES UNDER-23 MEN

Name: Phillip Berntsen Club: Winchester Coach: Keith Anderson Date of Birth: 18/01/1990

Biog: Phillip Berntsten was 18th at the European [junior] Cross Country Championships in 2008 in Brussels where the Aviva GB & NI junior men won team bronze. He recorded solid and consistent performances throughout 2009 but was less prominent in 2010 before returning in style with multiple PBs in 2011 and most recently a 15th place finish overall – third under-23 – in the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/European Cross Trials

Name: Matthew Gillespie Club: Shettleston Coach: Amanda Gillespie

Date of Birth: 04/11/1990

Biog: A member of the Aviva GB & NI junior men's team that won gold in the European Cross Country Championships in Dublin 2009, Matthew Gillespie finished in 14th place and was the fourth scoring athlete. The The21-year-old has won various notable titles this year including the Home Countries Cross Country International for the second year in succession and the Scottish National 4k Championships. He cemented his place on the 2011 Aviva GB & NI under-23 team with a strong run fifth place run at the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge, finishing 20th overall in the senior race.

Name: Mitch Goose Club: City of Norwich Coach: Tim/Pauline Ash Date of Birth: 16/03/1989

Biog: UK-based NCAA athlete Mitch Goose recently returned to the UK to compete in the European Cross Country Trial and his journey across the pond was a worthwhile one. Goose was the first under-23 athlete across the finish line in Liverpool and an impressive 12th overall in the senior race. He has won multiple European Cross Country Championships team medals for the Aviva GB & NI team but not yet won gold. His best individual placing was fifth in Dublin in 2009 when the team took silver. In last year's event, for which he also returned from the USA to the UK for the Trial, he finished third Brit in 22nd overall.

Name: Matthew Graham Club: Kirkintilloch Coach: Andrew Craycraft Date of Birth: 02/02/1991

Biog: Scotland's Matthew Graham has spent the last three years competing for DePaul University on the NCAA circuit in the USA. During spells back to the UK, he became the Aviva England Under-20 3000mSC champion in 2010 and went onto compete at the IAAF World Junior Championships in Canada in the same year. The McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/European Cross Trials was his first race back in the UK this year and his fifth place finish in the under-23 category earned him a place on the plane to Slovenia.

AVIVA GB & NI TEAM PROFILES UNDER-23 MEN

Name: Derek Hawkins Club: Kilbarchan AAC Coach: Lawrie Spence Date of Birth: 29/04/1989

Biog: Derek Hawkins, the 2011 Scottish National Cross Country champion, made a breakthrough in 2010 when he recorded lifetime best performances over 1500m (3:52.69), 3000m (8:27.5), one mile (4:05) and 10k (30.35). His year concluded with selection onto the Aviva GB & NI under-23 team. - his international debut - for the SPAR European Cross Country Championships in Portugal where he finished 48th. His progression has continued into 2011: he was the first Aviva GB & NI under-23 athlete home in the International Team Challenge at the BUPA Great Edinburgh Cross Country and was selected for the Aviva GB & NI senior team for the IAAF World Championships in Spain, where he finished 91st. He was 14th overall and second under-23 in the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/ European Cross Trials to make the team.

Name: James Wilkinson Club: Leeds City Coach: Phil Townsend Date of Birth: 13/07/1990

Biog: James Wilkinson was the European junior cross country bronze medallist in Dublin 2009 as part of a gold medal winning junior men's team. He was 107th in the 2010 IAAF World Cross. Country Championships in Poland and will be keen to banish the memories of last year's European. Cross event when he had to pull out through injury. Highlights to date in 2011 include a new lifetime best in the 3000mSC of 8:36.50, and while he won the Aviva England under-23 3000mSC title, he was unfortunate to miss out on selection for the European Under-23 Championships. He did however finish second in the Aviva World Trials and UK Championships later in the summer. On his return from the UKA/London Marathon altitude camp in Kenya he finished seventh under-23 in the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/European Cross Trial, 22nd overall, and was admittedly disappointed. A repeat of Dublin's 2009 podium. finish would be most welcome on this occasion.

Name: Lauren Howarth Club: Leigh

Coach: Bud Baldaro Date of Birth: 21/04/1990

Biog: Lauren Howarth, a Birmingham University medical student, won European (junior) Cross Country bronze in Brussels 2008, the memorable event in which the Aviva GB & NI women won gold after taking the top six positions. An experienced cross country athlete, she finished an impressive 13th and first team scorer in the 2009 World Cross in Jordan and after an injury hit summer returned to finish sixth in the European Cross in Dublin later that year. Track highlights in 2011 include PBs over 3000m (9:10:10) and 5000m (15:51.49) in addition to a guick 32:33 on the road to win Salford 10k. She finished 16th overall and sixth under-23 in the McCain Liverpool Cross Challenge/European Cross Trials to make the team for this event.

Name: Emma Pallant

Club: Aldershot, Farnham & District

Coach: Mick Woods Date of Birth: 04/06/1989

Biog: Tottenham Hotspur supporter Emma Pallant, a qualified physiotherapist, has impressive international Championship pedigree with highlights including European Cross Country bronze (under-23) in Albufeira, Portugal (2010), World Junior Championships 1500m bronze (2008) and a fourth place finish in the European Junior Championships (2007). She finished 27th in the iunior race at the 2008 IAAF World Cross Country Championships in Edinburgh and was fifth in the unbelievable European Cross in Brussels where Britain secured the top six positions in the junior women's race. After clocking a lifetime best of 15:54.40 for 5000m in May, she went onto finish seventh in the European Under-23 Championships in July 2011. 
