London 2012 will be Paul's first Paralympic Games.

A keen sportsman, Paul used to play basketball until he turned his attention to running. During his career, he has set World Records in both the T36 800m and 1500m and cites the greatest achievement of his career to date as his gold medal-winning performance in the T36 400m at the 2011 IPC Athletics World Championships in Christchurch, New Zealand.

He remains the current World Record holder in the 1500m with a time of 4:34.42, although that event is not in the programme for the London 2012 Games.

In addition to his sporting achievements, Paul, who has Cerebral Palsy, was awarded a BTEC in Sports Therapy from Weymouth College in 2009.

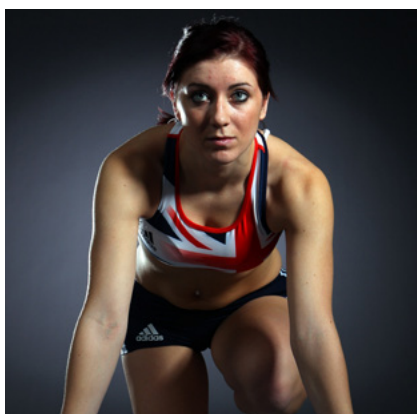
