UKA ASSISTANT OFFICIAL

ATTEND



COLLECT



SUBMIT

- Register and attend an Assistant Official's course
(Must be over 14 years of age)

- Gain experience by attending a minimum of 2 athletics meetings under the supervision of a qualified level 1 or above official
- Undertake a Police Records Disclosure check, if aged 16 or over, or if under 16 make a Self Declaration.
- Complete the UKA Safeguarding Course (16+ yrs)

- Submit application for accreditation
(Must be over 14 years of age)

UKA LEVEL 1 OFFICIAL

ATTEND

- Attend a Level 1 Officials Course in your chosen discipline
(Minimum 16 years of age)
- Complete the Health & Safety online course.
- Complete the online Safeguarding course

COLLECT

- Officiate at a minimum of 4 athletics meetings under the supervision of a qualified licensed official
- Organise police records disclosure check

SUBMIT

- Submit application form to Home Country Athletics Federation (HCAF)
(Minimum 16 years of age)

UKA LEVEL 2 OFFICIAL

COLLECT



SUBMIT

- All steps at LEVEL 1
- Complete the Level 2 questions for your discipline and submit to assessor

- Officiate at a **minimum** of 6 additional athletics meetings which must be completed after attending the Level 1 course
- Obtain 1 positive report from a meeting
- Show evidence of self-reflection within Record of Experience

- Submit application for accreditation, report form and record of experience to HCAF

UKA LEVEL 3 OFFICIAL

SUBMIT

- All steps at LEVEL 2

- Officiate at a minimum of 10 additional athletics meetings
- Obtain 2 positive reports from meetings (each discipline has specific requirements)
- Show evidence of mentoring and reflect on your own development

- Submit application for accreditation, report form and record of experience to HCAF

UKA LEVEL 4 OFFICIAL

SUBMIT

- All steps at LEVEL 3
- Register and attend Level 4 Official's Course & technology module in your chosen discipline
- Complete the Level 4 questions for your discipline and submit to assessor

- Show evidence of self-reflection and mentoring
- Officiate in at least 30 Track and Field meetings as a discipline specific Technical Official over 2 years (3 years allowed for PF)
- Minimum of 6 positive reports*

- Submit application for accreditation
